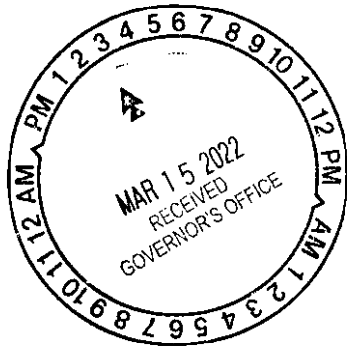

4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To provide a cost-of-living increase for state
6 employees for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Beginning with the first pay day on or
9 after October 1, 2022, all state employees who are listed in
10 the classified and unclassified service of the state as
11 defined in Section 36-26-10, Code of Alabama 1975, and all
12 other state employees and hourly employees of the state, and
13 all judicial personnel, officers, and employees, and all
14 legislative personnel, officers, and employees, whether
15 subject to the State Merit System or not, and all employees of
16 the county health departments who are employed subject to the
17 State Merit System and whose compensation is paid out of a
18 budget provided and agreed upon by the state, county, or other
19 contributing agency under the direction of the State Board of
20 Health shall receive a salary increase of four percent.

21 Section 2. (a) Any cost-of-living increase granted
22 under this act shall in no way apply to any local supplement
23 provided to any judges or to any other local employee whose
24 salary is tied to that of any state employee.

1 (b) This act shall not apply to any Merit System
2 employee or hourly employee whose service or rate of pay is
3 covered by any labor agreement or contract.

4 Section 3. The Director of the State Personnel
5 Department shall revise the schedule of rates set forth in the
6 pay plan for state employees and shall send the same to the
7 state Comptroller, who shall issue warrants in accordance
8 therewith. With respect to all court officials and employees
9 within the Unified Judicial System who serve the trial and
10 appellate courts of the state and the Administrative Office of
11 Courts, the Administrative Director of Courts shall revise the
12 schedule of rates set forth in the pay plan for these court
13 officials and employees to reflect the increase provided in
14 this act, and shall certify the same to the state Comptroller,
15 who shall issue warrants in accordance therewith. With respect
16 to employees of the Legislature, the Secretary of the Senate
17 for employees of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of
18 Representatives for employees of the House and the Director of
19 the Legislative Services Agency for employees of the
20 Legislative Services Agency shall revise the schedule of rates
21 set forth in the pay plan for their employees to reflect the
22 increase provided in this act and shall certify the same to
23 the state Comptroller, who shall issue warrants in accordance
24 therewith.

1 Section 4. It is not the intent of this act to make
2 appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act
3 shall be made in the annual budget act for the affected
4 entities.

5 Section 5. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.


