1 Enrolled, An Act,

Relating to the salaries of public education employees; 2 to provide for a revision of the State Minimum Salary Schedule 3 to reflect a pay increase of two percent beginning with the 4 5 fiscal year 2024-2025; to provide that each employee of certain boards of education shall receive the pay increase 6 7 according to placement on the appropriate salary step; to require the appropriate increases on the State Minimum Salary 8 9 Schedule; to provide support employees with a two percent pay 10 increase beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025; to require salary schedules; to provide the employees of certain other 11 public educational institutions and schools with a two percent 12 13 pay increase for the 2024-2025 fiscal year; to provide for an across the board salary increase on all two-year postsecondary 14 15 salary schedules, to establish other requirements on the two-year postsecondary salary schedules; and to establish 16 miscellaneous pay provisions relating to public education. 17 18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. PAY INCREASES, FY 2024-2025. (a) The State 19 20 Budget Officer shall allocate to the State Board of Education, the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Institute for Deaf and .21 Blind, the Board of Youth Services School District, the Board 22 23 of Directors of the Alabama School of Fine Arts, the Board of 24 Directors for the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and Engineering, and the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School 25 of Mathematics and Science and for disbursement to the 26 employees thereof funds based on the criteria established in 27 28 this act. It is not the intent of this act to make



appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act shall be made in the annual Education Trust Fund budget act for the designated fiscal year.

(1) Certificated Personnel (K-12). For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2024, and each year thereafter, each certificated employee at all city and county school systems and the teachers at the Department of Youth Services School District shall receive a two percent salary increase. Each step and cell on the State Minimum Salary Schedule contained in the annual budget act for the public schools shall be increased by the amounts below for fiscal year 2024-2025, the State Minimum Salary Schedule shall reflect the following percentage increase:

All certificated employees, including the Adult Basic Education and Science in Motion employees, shall be guaranteed pay increases in the amounts indicated above for their years of experience and degrees earned and the corresponding pay



85 increases shall be reflected in the appropriate local salary schedule and paid to each certificated employee. The 86 provisions and requirements of this act shall be in addition 87 88 to the provisions of Section 16-13-231.1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the State Minimum Salary Schedule. Each 89 certificated employee shall be properly placed on the local 90 salary schedule according to degree earned and years of public 91 education service (either in-state or out-of-state), which 92 93 shall be not less than the amounts appropriated for the State Minimum Salary Schedule. The employee shall be paid according 94 95 to degree earned and length of public education experience. The pay increase shall be given to each person employed for 96 the 2024-2025 fiscal year in addition to any state or local 97 step increase to which the employee is otherwise entitled. The 98 local board of education shall transmit to the State 99 Department of Education the appropriate notice of the earned 100 advanced degree for each employee in a timely fashion; 101 thereafter, the employee shall be paid for the advanced degree 102 as soon as the degree is certified to the State Department of 103 104 Education as being earned. (2) Education Support Personnel (K-12). A two percent 105 pay increase, beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025, shall 106 be paid to each public education support worker and adult bus 107 driver, including Adult Basic Education and Science in Motion 108 personnel, employed for the 2024-2025 fiscal year in addition 109

113 body or authority shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and type of employee and each step of 114 each salary schedule shall be increased to reflect a two 115 percent pay increase beginning with fiscal year 2024-2025, 116 which shall be given to the person employed full-time for the 117 2024-2025 fiscal year and each year employed full-time 118 119 thereafter. The base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be increased by two percent beginning with 120 fiscal year 2024-2025. A separate local salary schedule shall 121 be established and maintained for each specific job performed. 122

- (3) AIDB. For the fiscal year 2024-2025, employees at the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind shall receive a pay increase which shall be in excess of their salaries received during the 2023-2024 fiscal year. The increase shall be as follows:
- a. Certificated. The salary schedule for certificated
 employees shall be revised to reflect at least the following
 percentage increase beginning with the fiscal year 2024-2025:



A two percent pay increase, beginning with the 2024-2025 fiscal year, shall 145 146 be given to each support worker employed full-time by the 147 Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind. A separate local salary 148 schedule shall be established and maintained for each specific job performed. The pay increase in this act shall be 149 incorporated into the support employees' salary schedules. The 150 base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be 151 increased by two percent for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. 152 153 c. Miscellaneous Requirements. The AIDB board shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and 154 155 type of employee and each step of each salary schedule for fiscal year 2024-2025 shall be increased to reflect the pay 156 increase above to be given to each person employed for the , 157 158 2024-2025 fiscal year and each year employed thereafter. The pay increase contained in this subsection shall be paid to 159 160 each employee. 161 (4) Two-Year Postsecondary Institutions. The Board of Trustees of the Community College System shall revise all 162 salary schedules of the two-year postsecondary institutions to 163 164 reflect an increase of two percent for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. The pay increase shall be given to each person employed

in addition to any step increase to which the employee is 166 otherwise entitled. The Alabama Community College System shall 167 168

take proper steps to ensure that employees on all salary



schedules are given full credit for prior work experience in 169 the public schools and colleges, and shall take care to ensure 170 proper placements on the salary schedules. Placement on the 171 revised salary schedules shall be in accordance with the 172 employee's length of service in public education. No pay 173 increase shall be given to any two-year postsecondary employee 174 in excess of two percent, except as specifically provided in 175 176 this act.

- 177 (5) Miscellaneous provisions. The following provisions 178 are hereby established:
- a. Fiscal Year. All salaries and salary increases which are established by the State Board of Education shall be paid in full to each person employed before the end of the applicable fiscal year as defined in Section 16-1-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.
- b. Extended Work. Public K-12 school employees on

 contracts which extend beyond 187 days, or the hourly

 equivalent thereof, shall be given a pro rata salary increment

 for each or partial day of work extending beyond 187 days.

c. Local Increment. Any cost-of-living adjustment and/or increase on the State Minimum Salary Schedule for teachers as provided in this act shall be exclusive of any local pay increase granted or due to teachers under provisions of any local salary schedule. Any cost-of-living adjustment and/or pay increase required by this act for public school support personnel shall be in addition to any pay increase due or granted to the employee under provisions of any local salary schedules. The pay increase provisions of this act



- 197 shall not apply to any salary supplements granted by local
- 198 boards of education, bonuses earned for certification by the
- 199 National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, or the
- 200 federal portion of the salary paid to a Junior Reserve Officer
- 201 Training Corps (JROTC) instructor employed by a local school
- 202 board.
- d. Community Education. Each county and city board of
- 204 education shall have the option to exclude from the provisions
- of this act any part-time employees of community education or
- 206 school-sponsored child care or child enrichment program which
- 207 is supplemental to the state-required educational program.
- e. Local Chief Executive Officers. The pay increase
- 209 provisions of this act shall not apply to superintendents of
- 210 education of any school system or institution. Any pay
- 211 increase given to the superintendent shall be by majority
- 212 recorded vote of the governing body or authority.
- 213 Section 2. The pay increase granted in this act shall
- 214 begin in fiscal year 2024-2025 and continue in subsequent
- 215 years. Nothing in this act shall authorize additional pay
- 216 increases in subsequent years.
- Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable. If
- 218 any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional,
- 219 that declaration shall not affect the part which remains.
- 220 Section 4. This act shall become immediately following
- 221 its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise
- 222 becoming law.
